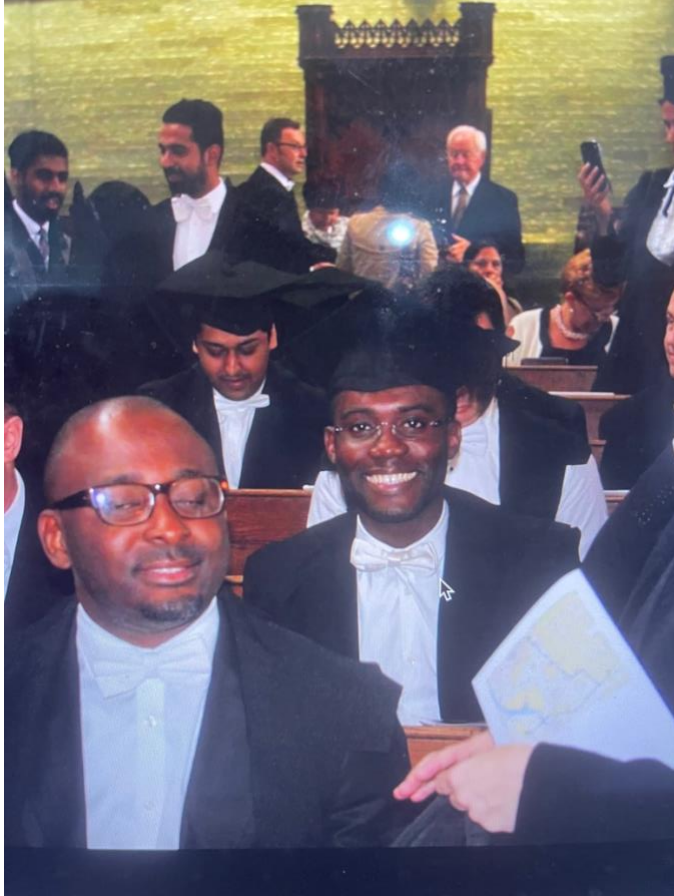

## Profile



**Lars Løkke Rasmussen** is the Prime Minister of Denmark and Chairman of the political party Venstre. During his 30 year political career he has been City Council Member, Member of Parliament, Minister of Domestic Affairs and Health, Minister of Finance and Prime Minister for two sittings.



**Ignacio Garcia Bercero** is the EU Chief TTIP Negotiator and Director at DG for Trade of the European Commission. Since 2012 he has been responsible for overseeing all activities in the fields of Neighbouring Countries, US or Canada as well as being the Chief Negotiator for the EU India FTA.



**Rufus Gifford** is the U.S. Ambassador to the Kingdom of Denmark. He most recently served as Finance Chair of the Presidential Inaugural Committee. He served as Finance Director for Obama for America from 2011 to 2012, and as Finance Director for the Democratic National Committee from 2009 to 2011.



**Ambassador Lars Thuesen** is Denmark's Permanent State Secretary of Trade and Strategy. He has had distinguished career as a diplomat including serving as the Danish Ambassador to Spain and Andorra. He has over 25 years of experience in the Danish foreign service.



**Matti Anttonen** is the Under-Secretary of State for External Economic Affairs in the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland. Prior to his current position, he served as Director General of the Department for External Economic Relations. He holds Masters Degrees both in economics and in modern history.



**Jörgen Halldin** is the Head of the Department for International Trade Policy at the Swedish Foreign Ministry. He served as Consul-General of Sweden in Hong Kong or Macau before returning to Sweden this year. He holds Master Degree in International Business and Economics from University of Lund.



**Richard Bergström** is the Director General of the European Federation of Pharmaceutical Industries and Associations (EFPIA). He served as the Director General of the Swedish Association of the Pharmaceutical Industry for nine years, following positions in regulatory affairs at Roche and Novartis. He received his MSc.Pharm degree from the University of Uppsala.



**Erik Bergelin** is the Trade and Economics Director ACEA (European Automobile Manufacturers Association) representing the interests of the Automobile Manufacture with the EU and other relevant stakeholders. He previously held the positions of Supplier Account Manager for steel and aluminium products at Renault, and Vice President Executive Director for Purchasing of Dacia.



**Jan O. F. Laustsen** is the Director of Trade, Markets & Nutrition at the Danish Food and Agriculture Council. His fields of responsibility include bilateral trade agreements, market development, export promotion and development of aid policy and relations to UN-bodies. He is also responsible for offices in Tokyo, Beijing and London Trade Union SE.



**Dr. Silke Trummer** is a political economist from the University of Helsinki working on the global trading system. Her research interests include development studies, social movement studies and international law. She works with DG Trade at the European Commission and the International Trade Centre. She is member of the Finni Stop TTIP Alliance.



**Kenneth Haar** is a researcher with Corporate Europe Observatory (CEO), a lobby watchdog based in Brussels. CEO follows the TTIP negotiations closely and has produced several reports on the negotiations. He is a graduate in history and sociology from Roskilde University and Lund University.



**Jason Hammondtree** works at the Economic Section at the U.S. Mission to the EU in Brussels. He served Mexico and the Bureau of Economic and Business Affairs in Washington. Before the State Department, Jason was corporate attorney in Chicago. He has a law degree from Columbia Law School.



**Prof. Heikki Patomäki** is Professor of World Politics at the University of Helsinki and a civic and political activist. He is a member of the board of ATTAC Finland. His academic interests include global political economy and global political theory. He is member of the Scientific Council of Progressive Economy, an initiative of the S&D Group of the European Parliament.



**Benedicte Federspiel** is a lawyer and was the Executive Director of the Danish Consumer Council. Her work focus on legal matters, advisory committees, European and international consumer policy. She is a member of the European Consumer Consultative Group and member of the advisory Group of DG Trade on TTIP.
